

Current Accommodations

- Designated quiet room with a live stream of the program
- American Sign Language (ASL) interpreter on-site during the program
- Closed Captioning for all videos during the program
- Accessible entrance
- Volunteers available to assist attendees
- Service animals are welcome during the event
- Event signage is translated into Spanish, Somali, and Hmong
- Wellness room for lactation, religious practices, or other needs
- All signs for event rooms include Braille
- Drinking fountains available between the Pavilion and the Great Northern spaces
- Defibrillator available on site
- An all-gender restroom available outside of the Great Northern space

- Wheelchair seating at dinner tables
- Dinner is available at a later time if observing Ramadan
- Halal meal option for dinner
- Gluten-free meal option for dinner

Potential Barriers

- Many of the event spaces can get very crowded and noisy
- This event is not scent-free
- Attendees will not be required to provide proof of vaccination, proof of negative COVID test, or wear face masks at The Depot
- Most of the spaces use fluorescent lighting
- Some of the flooring in the event spaces, like the Great Northern and the Pavilion, are carpeted and could make wheeled travel more difficult
- Children are welcome, but the program, dinner, and activities are planned with adults in mind, and the whole event may run over 3 hours.
- The sidewalks immediately outside the building and in the parking lot may be uneven and subject to weather conditions, such as water buildup from rain or ice if the weather is still cold.
